#### Parking for the concert:

Parking at the school is a challenge. We have arranged additional parking at the church down the road located at 49379 Chilliwack Central Road. We will have a school bus to shuttle people to and from the church parking lot before and after both concerts. We ask that you only park in designated parking spots at the church and to please respect their property as they were kind enough to allow us to use it. We also ask to please respect our neighbouring properties and to not block their driveways or park on their lawns.

Steps for Online Fieldtrip Permission:



SD33 Pay Online (the tab is on the school website).

-Click on the box for the fieldtrip.

-Once you've read the fieldtrip information...**you must select the homeroom teacher in the drop down menu**. If you do not select the homeroom teacher, the form won't process for payment.

The student's name automatically populates in the permission form.

-Complete all the information of the form.
-Click the box for permission and sign the form.
-Add to your cart. In the top right corner, you should see it in the cart symbol.
-Click on the cart for payment and form completion.

This event is open to all families who have children entering Kindergarten for September 2025 in the Chilliwack School District. Although we are hosting the events at Central & Unsworth Elementary, your child can be registered at any Chilliwack Elementary School. Please join us at one of our 2 events happening at Central Elementary and Unsworth Elementary. If you are not registered for Kindergarten yet, we can help! Please bring the following items with you:

- a valid email address
- photo or scan showing proof of child's age and citizenship (birth certificate, passport...)
- photo or scan showing proof of residency (utility bill with your name...)
- photo or scan showing parent's proof of citizenship (I.D., passport...)
- immigration and employment information if a temporary resident in BC

\*Younger siblings are welcome to join, please note that guardians are required to supervise their children at this event.



# INCLEMENT WEATHER SCHOOL CLOSURE GUIDELINES

#### Information for Parents and Students



Inclement weather conditions such as freezing rain, significant snowfall or high wind can occur during the fall and winter months. In such conditions, decisions on the opening or closure of school district facilities are made by the Superintendent of Schools in consultation with management and supervisory staff who have checked first-hand on the driving conditions, walking/sidewalk conditions, and general condition of buildings and accessibility to sites. For more details on how this is done, click here.

While service to students and parents is a priority and schools will be kept open as much as is reasonably possible, student and staff safety is the primary consideration.

In the event of extreme weather conditions, parents are urged to check the School District website <a href="https://www.sd33.bc.ca">www.sd33.bc.ca</a> or tune into radio stations STAR FM (98.3 FM) or JR COUNTRY (89.5 FM), to receive up-to-date information on school closures and information on bussing. Reports will start after 6:00 a.m. and will be repeated often. There is no need to call your school, the School District Office or the radio station.

When there is extreme weather and schools remain open, student attendance is the parent/guardians' decision.
